Special Dairy Goat Rules

(Also See General Rules & Regulations & Health Regulations)

- The original registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older and must be shown to the Show Secretary before the start of the show. The original registration certificate, duplicate application or fax copy stamped by the ADGA office is required for all animals under six months of age, and this must be shown to the Show Secretary before the start of the show. Exhibitors are reminded that all tattoos must be readable.
- The base date for the Senior Doe and Junior Doe Shows is August 6, 2021.
- Entry fee is \$3.00 per head. Pens will be available (no bedding) and **exhibitors MUST clean pens before leaving. Entries must be made online** at our website, www.howardcountyfairmd.com (follow the appropriate link) until July 1st. See Rule #10 in the General Rules and Regulations. Please pre-enter group classes. Early filing may get preference in case of limited space. **Each farm is limited to 40 animals.** Animals must be on the fairgrounds on Thursday, August 5th by 6 pm, and checked in by 8 am on Friday, August 6th and may leave after the show and must be gone by 10 pm. Substitutions may be made. Exhibitors may not receive more than two (2) money awards in any class.
- This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association, and their rules shall govern. Only ADGA, AGS, and CGS registered, recorded or applied for animals may be shown. The Senior Doe Show is sanctioned by ADGA for the following breeds: Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Saanen, Toggenburg, All Other Purebred (AOP), and Recorded Grade. The Junior Doe Show is sanctioned by ADGA for Alpine, All Other Purebred, Nigerian Dwarf, and Recorded Grade. The Junior Doe Show and the Senior Doe Shows are separately sanctioned.
- Maryland or Inter-state Health Papers will be required of all animals. Original certificate should be in exhibitor's possession on the fairgrounds.
- All goats must be provided with a collar. There will be no pre-show milkout. The judge will discriminate against over-extended udders. Exhibitors are requested to show in ADGA show or 4-H/FFA attire.
- A Rosette and Special Award will be presented to all Breed Champions.

The order of the show is subject to change due to emergency as determined by the Show Committee.

1. Milkers Under 2 Years
2. Milkers 2 Years and Under 3 Years
3. Milkers 3 Years and Under 4 Years
4. Milkers 4 years and under 5
5. Milkers 5 Years and Under 7
6. Milkers 7 and older
7. Dry Doe (must have freshened at least once)
8. Senior Champion (By Breed) – Rosette ONLY
9. Reserve Senior Champion (By Breed) – Rosette ONLY
10. Champion Challenge
11. Dam and Daughter (2 animals, any age)*
12. Get of Sire (3 does any age, same sire)*
13. Dairy Herd (3 does in milk, owned by same farm)*
14. Best Senior Doe in Show – BANNER

Division 2 - ADGA Junior Doe Show - Follows Senior Doe Show

Breed Classes for Each Breed Will be Shown in the following order:

**D01 (JA)Alpine; D02- Nigerian Dwarf, D03 All Other Purebreds (AOP),
D04- Recorded Grade**

Class

15. Junior Kid (born on/after 4/1/21)
16. Intermediate Kid (born 3/1/21 - 3/31/21)
17. Senior Kid (Born on/after 12/1/19 and before 3/1/20)
18. Dry Yearling (born before 12/1/19 & under 2 and never freshened)
19. Junior Grand Champion (By Breed) - Rosette ONLY
20. Junior Reserve Grand Champion (By Breed) - Rosette ONLY
21. Junior Best 3 Females - All animals must have been shown in Classes 15-18. All Bred & Owned by one(1) exhibitor
22. Best Junior Doe in Show -Banner (ALL Junior Champions in the Junior Doe Show must compete)

Special Notes:

**Permanent champions may be shown in the appropriate age class or the Champion challenge but not both.*

**All Best of Breeds Class 22 from the Junior Doe Show and from Class 14 in the Senior Doe Show must compete for Best Doe in Show or will forfeit championship leg earned at this show.*

** For Classes 11 & 12, combined ownership is permitted. Exhibitors must specify who gets the premium at check-in.*

** For Class 13, combined ownership with animals from the same farm is permitted.*
