RIDERS UNDER 18 YEARS OLD MUST WEAR A HELMET!

Class List – 9:00 Fastest times win. Cross entering allowed in classes where 2 entries run.

1. Texas Barrels – Weave thru 3 barrels
2. Texas Barrels Walk-Trot/Jog
3. Barrels – Cloverleaf pattern around 3 barrels
4. Barrels Walk-Trot/Jog
5. Bleeding Heart – Open heart pattern around 3 barrels
6. Bleeding Heart Walk-Trot/Jog
7. Relay Race – Second rider waits at the far end of the ring. First rider is handed a baton and races around the perimeter of the ring and passes the baton to the second rider. Transfer must be done between the 2 cones. Second rider races for the finish line. Second rider must cross timers in the lead.
8. Relay Race Walk Trot/Jog
9. Plug Race – Race down and around the single barrel and back thru timers.
10. Plug Race Walk Trot/Jog
11. Ribbon Race – Riders are handed each end of a piece of crepe paper ribbon. They race around the barrels and return thru the timers without breaking or releasing the ribbon.
12. Ribbon Race Walk-Trot/Jog
13. Boot Race – Rider races to their boot at the other end of the ring, puts boot on and remounts and races back thru the timers. **Boot must be completely on the foot.** Horse holders may be provided at the boot. This class may be held in heats for safety.
14. Boot Race Walk-Trot/Jog
15. Flag Race – Rider races to first barrel, picks up flag from the bucket, carries flag around the second barrel and places it back in the bucket on the first barrel and races thru the timers. If flag falls out of the bucket, entry is disqualified.
16. Flag Race Walk-Trot/Jog
17. Costume Class – Dress up the horse, rider, dog, etc. Best costume wins
