1. All rules from 4-H Department Rules apply.
2. 4-H members are encouraged to join the fun by submitting a descriptive, legible narration of no more than 150 words in the 4-H Building by 12:00 Noon, **Saturday, August 13th**. Scripts more than 150 words will be cut in length. All narrations accepted at time of registration must have category selected and placed on narration sheet. This story will be read to the audience by the Master of Ceremonies during presentation. 4-Hers carrying the Public Speaking project have the opportunity for this speaking experience. Those interested must notify 4-H Office by July 26th.
3. Clovers (5-7) may only use a stuffed animal in order to participate in the New Zoo Revue Show.
4. Previous year entries are not eligible for competition.
5. The costumed animal (rabbits, poultry, dog, large animal, etc.) and the descriptive narration (not the costumed 4-H'er) will be judged. Please enter one of the following categories.
 1. Prettiest
 2. Most Creative
 3. Funniest
 4. The animal that stole the show
 5. Smallest
 6. Best Representing 4-H
 7. Animal with most character
 8. Animal from a Fairy Tale
6. All animals must meet Fair Health Requirements. **Health papers should be with the 4-H'er at all times.** Dogs are not to leave the show ring area and are to leave the fairgrounds at the conclusion of the show.
