3. **Each article must be accompanied by a plan, blue print, working drawing or sketch, used in construction or the refinishing method along with a statement of intended use in order to be fully judged. Animal house plans must state the kind of animal the house is designed for. Enclose plans in an envelope and securely attach to the article. Size requirements 3'x6'x5' (Maximum size).**
4. All entries must be made of worked wood (i.e. cut, shaped and sanded, etc.) Kits are allowed only if wood has been worked in all classes but class 8. (**Specify if a kit**)
