- The original registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older and must be shown to the Show Secretary before the start of the show. The original registration certificate or stamped duplicate application stamped by the ADGA Office is required for all animals under six months of age and this must be shown to the Show Secretary before the start of the show. Exhibitors are reminded that all tattoos must be readable.
- 2. The base date for the Senior Doe and Junior Doe Shows is August 4, 2022. Location of the show is the Howard County Fairgrounds, West Friendship, MD. Entry fee is \$3.00 per head. Pens will be available (no bedding) and exhibitors must clean pens before leaving. All entries must be made online at our website, www.howardcountyfairmd.org (follow the appropriate link) until July 1st. See Rule #10 in the General Rules and Regulations. Please pre-enter group classes. Early filing may get preference in case of limited space. Each farm is limited to 40 animals. Animals must be on the fairgrounds on Thursday, August 3rd by 5 pm, and checked in before the shows start. Exhibitors may leave after the show and must be gone by 7 pm on Friday. Substitutions may be made. Exhibitors may not receive more than two (2) money awards in any class.
- 3. This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and their rules shall govern. Only ADGA, AGS, and CGS registered, recorded, or applied for animals may be shown. This **Senior Doe Show** is sanctioned by ADGA for the following breeds: Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Saanen, Toggenburg, All Other Purebred (AOP), and Recorded Grade. The **Junior Doe Show** is sanctioned for Alpine, LaMancha, All Other Purebred, Nigerian Dwarf and Recorded Grade. The Senior Doe Shows and Junior Doe Shows are separately sanctioned.
- 4. Maryland or Interstate Health Papers will be required of all animals. Original certificate should be in exhibitor's possession on the grounds.
- 5. All goats must be provided with a collar. There will be no pre-show milkout. The judge will discriminate against over-extended udders. Exhibitors are requested to show in ADGA show or 4-H/FFA attire.
- 6. A Rosette will be presented to all Breed Champions.
- 7. The order of the show is subject to change due to emergency as determined by the Show Committee.
