- All Horses and Mules, six months or older are to have proof of negative Coggins test within 12 months of the show date. A copy is be presented at check in the day of the show. All equine exhibitors are to fill out a <u>Self-Certification of Equine</u> Health form and is to be presented to the designated fair or show representative at check in.
- Show will be held rain or shine. All fees are non-refundable.
- No entries accepted after the deadline.
- Must use entry form in this catalog. ONLY ONE RIDER/DRIVER PER ENTRY FORM. Mail all entries to: Brenda Sands, 408 South Springdale Road, New Windsor, MD 21776. Please make check payable to: Howard County Fair Association, Inc.
- All Judges' decisions are final. Any Horse or Mule misbehaving is to be dismissed.
- Show committee reserves the right to combine or split classes as number of entries warrant. Classes are listed in the tentative order they are to be run may be changed as needed.
- Appropriate attire for each draft horse class is required.
- Youth may waive their youth status and are to clearly state on their entry form with Parental Permission. They are not to be considered a youth in the MDHMA point system and may not exhibit in youth classes for the reminder of the calendar year.
- Adult Youth Showmanship classes: Judged 70% showmanship, 30% condition and grooming of the animal.
   Premiums: Trophy and Six ribbons. Pee-Wee Showmanship 7yrs & Under. They MUST be accompanied by an experienced Adult at all times when entering the ring and is required to wear protective head gear.
- Senior Showmanship is for 65 yrs & Older & Other Showmanship is for people with Restricted Mobility
  with Horses or Mules will be WALK ONLY. You can show in one or the other. You cannot show in both.
  When showing in these classes the SHOWMAN will not be allowed to show in any other single
  registered halter classes.
- All Youth 8-19 are to be accompanied by an experienced adult in any driving classes.
- All draft horse halter classes Open to registered Draft & Drum Horses Only.
- All Stallion classes are for registered Draft Stallions only. Stallions over one year of age may not be shown by any youth.
- Mule classes: Mules must be at least 15hh or taller to show in any mule class.
- Under Saddle Classes: English or Western tack, no driving bridles or bareback pads. Judged as a pleasure riding class at a walk and trot or jog both ways of the ring. To stand quietly and back easily. No stallions. Pee-Wee Lead-line must be accompanied by an experienced Adult with Line in Hand when entering the ring and is required to wear protective head gear.
- ALL exhibitors showing under saddle are to wear protective head gear. (English & Western).
- Hitch Classes: Are to be judged at a walk and trot both ways of the ring. Judged on manners, suitability, condition and performance of team and driver. May be asked to back or perform individual test at judge's discretion. Youth classes judged on driver performance only.
- Multiple Mule Hitch Three or more Mules hitched, including abreast and tandem. Are to be judged at a walk
  and trot both ways of the ring. Judged on manners, suitability, condition and performance of team and driver.
  May be asked to back or perform individual test at judge's discretion.
- Pleasure Single Cart and Pleasure Team Classes Draft Horse or Mule (one horse or mule for pleasure driving and two for Pleasure team) hitched to cart or 4-wheeled vehicle. No fancy carts, braiding is optional, No show harness, No scotch housing. These animals may be pure draft, draft cross-breeds or mules. If, you

show Pleasure these animals may not be shown in any other hitch classes. These animals may be shown under saddle.

- Senior Single Cart Class Draft Horse or Mule, Must be 65 years of age and Older.
- All classes are to be given a final gate call. You are not to be allowed into the show ring once the gate is closed. The judge is to determine the time allowed for last call.
- To be eligible to show in classes 56-60, you must have shown both in their respective halter classes.
- Senior & Reserve, Junior & Reserve, Grand Champion & Reserve Champions: Premiums: Ribbons only.
- Premiums for classes 1 thru 61 are \$25, \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5 and ribbons.
- Premiums for classes 62 thru 65 are Ribbons.
